Over 80 years old, this graceful and iconic span (which connects Marin County) is an unforgettable place to ride, walk or cycle over. You can even fly a plane. 02 25 Ponder your adventure while in Golden Gate Park. With its thousand-plus acres of gardens, lakes, bridal and walking paths, the Strybing Arboretum at the San Francisco Botanical Garden and the peaceful Japanese Tea House and Garden, originally part of the 1894 World's Fair Exhibition. Tea drinkers have views of the kose and pond, which is framed by fragrant wisteria. 03 25 Macduff Everton/Getty Images There's really something else like the California Academy of Sciences. Combining innovative architecture and exciting exhibitions, the Academy is home to the Steinhart Aquarium, Morrison Planetarium, Kimball Natural History Museum, and four-storey rainforest under one green roof. 04 25 Address Fisherman's Wharf, San Francisco, CA, US City's most popular destination, Fisherman's Wharf overlooking San Francisco Bay and Golden Gate Bridge. The historic waterfront is still a working fish dock, so there are fresh seafood in the area. Nearby San Francisco attractions such as Pier 39, Cannery and Ghirardelli Square are for tourists, but prove irresistible to many visitors. Proceed to 5 for 25 below. 05 25 Daniel Osterkamp/Getty Images A short ferry ride to Alcatraz Cruises, LLC deposits for you on Alcatraz Island and the self-guided Alcatraz Cellhouse Audio Tour is available in many languages. Evening tours, run by park guides, are also available on this island-of-no-escape from San Francisco Bay (Ferry departs from Pier 33). 06 25 Moving historic landmarks, San Francisco cable cars operate seven days a week along century-old routes. For a unique tour of the city, take the California Street line, which runs from the Financial District through Chinatown and over Nob Hill. The Powell-Mason line ends near Fisherman's Wharf and the Powell-Hyde line ends at the Water Park near Ghirardelli Square. Aboard the San Francisco cable car at each cable turntable where you can see the brown-and-white stop sign. 07 of 25 dragon-draped archway at the Bush Street and Grant Avenue announce the entrance to Chinatown in San Francisco, known as the largest Chinatown outside Asia. The streets are teem with fish and vegetable stalls, herbal shops, temples and eateries. Hunan Home's and R&G Lounge restaurants rate high-end guests. Proceed to 9 25 below. 09 25 Address in Alamo Square, where San Francisco circa-1900s Victorian homes are juxtaposed against towering backdrops of downtown skyscrapers. The area is bordered by Broderick Street and Webster Street to the east and west and Oak street and Golden Gate Avenue to the north and south. Lombardi Street, the world's most crooked, is also a sight to behold. Its vertiginous road winds past ornate houses and descends sharply (between Hyde and Leavenworth streets). 10 25 StephanHoerold/Getty Images Address presidio in San Francisco, San Francisco, CA, USA, the beautifully scenic Presidio was a military post for over 200 years until 1994, when it became part of the National Park Service. Guests can enjoy the sidewalks, quiet green areas and recreation areas, cafes, restaurants and other businesses. Don't miss a bike ride through Crissy Field golden gate bridge. 11 25 Mission District has a rich multicultural heritage: Immigrants from Europe and later people from Mexico, Central America, South America and the Caribbean arrived here. This mainly Latino district is a festive place to visit. You'll need to post classic taquerias, Mexican bakeries and specialty shops, as well as various colorful public murals alongside more gentrified contingent trendy restaurants, bars, nightclubs and cafes. 12 25 NicolasMcComber/Getty Images In the heart of San Francisco, you'll find the lively Castro, a historic center of the gay community where artists hang out and tourists and locals both enjoy a variety of restaurants, boutiques and bars, along with a free children's museum. Castro's theatre stands out as a landmark for the region; The area is also known as political activist Harvey Milk was its headquarters for the gay pride movement in the 60s and 70s. Proceed to 13 25 below. 13 25 Katrin Engel/EyeEm/Getty Images A great way to explore this dynamic and vibrant city is with an expert guiding you along as you travel on foot, learn about the history and culture of local neighborhoods. Several companies offer excursions – do you want to Through the city of Chinatown, Castro District, or other neighborhoods, or check out the rural landscapes for a free green walk or hike-there is really something for everyone. 14 of 25 Address Haight-Ashbury, San Francisco, CA 94117, USA If you want to experience where all things hippie took place in the 60s, head to where Haight and Ashbury streets meet. It's hard not to imagine incense filled days earlier when you walk into the heart where the 1967 Summer of Love took place-100,000 people converged on Haight and the famous Grateful Dead band made the neighborhood home. You'll find restaurants, vintage clothing shops, smoke shops, art shops, cafes, lovely Victorian homes, and beyond. 15 25 Address sausalito, CA 94965, USA If you take a real ride north about 30 minutes over the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco, you can come after the small town of Sausalito, a great place to spend a day in the Bay Area. Another fun way to transport Sausalito takes the ferry to Fisherman's Wharf. When you arrive, you can enjoy a houseboat-filled, lovely city and some winning views of San Francisco, complete with galleries, shops and restaurants. 16 25 Address pacific heights, San Francisco, CA, U.S. Victorian homes and mountainous streets to remind many people when dreaming of a trip to San Francisco; but some prefer not to walk famously steep hills. The Victorian Home Walk guides you around the Pacific Heights neighborhood, avoiding the mountains and giving a tour accessible to people with no abilities. With their knowledge, you'll see more than 200 restored homes, filming location for the movie Mrs Doubtfire, and where celebrities like Robin Williams and Don Johnson lived. Public tours take place on Mondays, Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays; private excursions are at your chosen time. In both cases, reservations need to be made. Proceed to 17 25 below. 17 of 25 Address Twin Peaks, San Francisco, CA, USA Some large Bay Area and city views from above, head to Twin Peaks near the city's geographic center, also one of the stops along San Francisco's Scenic 49-Mile Drive. Two adjacent peaks stand at 922 feet each. This internationally renowned attraction is part of the nearly 65-acre Twin Peaks Natural Area, where you can hopefully get a glimpse of the endangered Mission Blue Butterfly, rabbits, coyotes, native plants and coastal scrubs, among other flora and fauna. 18 25 DavidCallan/Getty Images Visited five U.S. presidents and other famous people, the beloved Cliff House restaurant just north of Ocean Beach-which is out of fires, earthquakes and dynamite explosion-has been restored and houses bistro restaurant, bringing its larger incarnations since it all began in 1858. Other restaurants, cafes, bars and attractions can be found nearby. For more information on the fascinating history of this area, stop at the Lands End Lookout visitor center above Cliff House. North of Cliff House, find out Baths opened in 1896: the building housed former saltwater pools, an ice skating rink, restaurants and an amphitheatre. 19 25 Address in Union Square, San Francisco, CA 94108, U.S. Union Square is a great shopping area and beloved tourist attraction where you can sip coffee and people-watch an outdoor setting, head inside nice restaurants for everything from sushi to Mexican or French cuisine, or experience art galleries and shops galore. Due to the taste of history, you'll find out about fame walk, where you have some of the oldest guests at Diva Geary Street. Or get your theater at the American Conservatory, also geary. 20 of 25 This museum, full of science, art and other engaging experiences, is very interactive and educational, and for 50 years it has been a great place to involve the whole family. Embarcadero 15. Check out your reduced rates and community days (pay what you want). Proceed to 21 of 25 below. 21 25 Another one of San Francisco's lovely spots to take in the views of the Coit Tower, a 210-foot structure atop Telegraph Hill, dating back to 1933. If you take the lift to the top of the tower, you have a terrace with panoramic views of the city and the surrounding bay, including the Bay and the Golden Gate Bridges. At the bottom of the tower are murals created in 1934 displaying California's lifetime depression. Tickets can be purchased at a nearby ticket shop; the site is open all year round, except thanksgiving day, Christmas Day and New Year. 22 25 San Francisco is delightfully full of colorful, creative streets, and part of that charm is its myriad diverse murals, some of the country's best. This street art can be found in everything from churches home to public and private businesses. Fog City is home to more than 1,000 street murals you can explore in any type of weather. Most of them are in the Mission District, followed by the South of Market and downtown/Tenderloin area. 23 25 Andrei Stanescu/Getty Images If you don't mind likely traffic, you can ride, cycle, or walk across the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, commonly called the Bay Bridge. explore the East Bay and its many neighborhoods. By car, Berkeley is about an hour from San Francisco, and home to the famous University of California, Berkeley, hippies who have been around since the 60s, and many ethnic restaurants, shops, cafes, parks, and other ways to have fun. Oakland is about a 20-minute drive from Berkeley. There are various areas where everything is possible, from outdoor concerts to successful shops and trendy cafes. 24 25 TripSavvy/Melissa Zink Address Baker Beach, San Francisco, CA, USA While it's not the safest swimming beach, views of the Golden Gate Bridge and The scenery is unforgettable in Baker Beach, so walk to this place without an entrance or parking fee. Also, the San Francisco Ferry Building hosts an outdoor organic farmer market several days a week throughout the year; The biggest market is Saturday morning, so don't miss it if you love seasonal, fresh produce. History lovers enjoy the building's 240-foot clock tower, which has been a water landmark for over 100 years. Years.
